Dear Learners, Parents and Carers

I am writing to tell you about an exciting event that is happening to wrap up our Heritage Lottery funded project, Cogs2Computers on Wednesday 7 July at The Denny in Swaffham Bulbeck, which you are welcome to join us for. The event is taking place 11am-3pm, and you can attend for as long or as little as you wish.

We will be joining students at the local primary school and limited numbers of members of the public to come together to see and understand the learning which has taken place during the Cogs2Computers project. Andy Hamilton (our patron, comedian, and the voice of Dr Elephant in Peppa Pig!) will be joining us for the day and will be battling it out on the gaming station against willing participants. We look forward to sharing our work with everyone.

We will be taking our usual Covid-secure measures to the event, and Learner bubbles will be travelling to the site with their support workers, which will include having 15 minutes to see other displays and 30 minutes to sit at their socially distanced table, with their support workers, to present their Cogs2Computers work. They will then travel back to their Red2Green site directly after.

Other Covid-secure measures will include:

- Cleaning between each bubble's visit
- Social distancing, in line with current regulations
- Mask wearing for staff and visitors (this is not required for learners and school children), despite being an outdoor event
- Track and Trace sign in
- Toilets are available at the pavilion, and these will be cleaned regularly
